We are an accredited member of the **Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI)** which approves our School. The ACSI is recognized by the Department of Children and Families (formerly HRS), which means that we are inspected and under the direct authorization of ACSI. We must follow the guidelines mandated by Florida Law as well as maintain the high standards required by the ACSI. We have also been a Florida Gold Seal School since 2005.






Our School is a nondenominational Christian ministry and is open to all students without regard to race, creed, color, or national origin. The School is governed by a School Board of Directors established by the church. We are a nonprofit school and tuition directly goes toward operation of the School.



Our Program

At St. Paul Methodist School, we are dedicated to the Lord Jesus Christ and his admonition, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the Kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." Matthew 19:14. Our educational program includes experiences described above as well as concern for each child to experience God's love.



Preschool and Primary School Classes Offered

Two year old classes (2 by September 1st)
2 days (Tues/Thurs), 3 days (Mon/Wed/Fri) or 5 days (Mon- Fri)
Ratios of 1:6 (teacher to student) with a maximum of twelve children per room.

Three year old classes (3 by September 1st)
2 days (Tues/Thurs), 3 days (Mon/Wed/Fri) or 5 days (Mon-Fri)
Ratios of 1:7 (teacher to student) with a maximum of thirteen children per room.

Voluntary Pre-K (VPK) classes - (4 by September 1st) 4days (Mon-Thurs)
Ratios of 1:11 (teacher to student) with a maximum of thirteen children per room.
All children who are four years old by September 1st of the current school year may participate in the Florida VPK Program. VPK students must present St. Paul with a state "voucher" before beginning this program.

K-4 (4 by December 1st)
5 days (Monday - Friday)
Ratios of 1:7 (teacher to student)

Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd Grade
5 days (Monday - Friday)

Science and Computer Lab
Art/Music and Daily P.E.

Ratios of 1:13 (teacher to student) with a maximum of thirteen children per room.

Registration Fee

An annual, non-refundable registration fee of \$85.00 is due at enrollment.

Voluntary Pre-K Students (VPK)

VPK-ONLY - By law, children who attended VPK programs may not be charged ANY fees for the 540 hours the program is in session for the school term. Therefore, students who are enrolling in VPK and attend ONLY from 8:30AM to 12:30PM, Monday - Thursday pay nothing.



VPK + Day (Friday)—VPK students who attend on Friday must pay the \$85.00 **non-refundable** registration fee and will pay ONLY \$80.00 per month.
